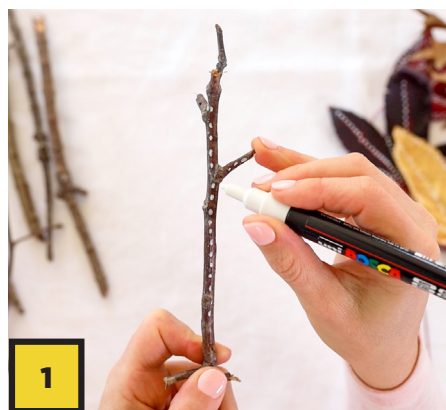


MAKE A NATURE CROWN

Clever

This project is a wonderful way to connect with nature and create something fun! Gather up some leaves and sticks, and follow this method to make nature crowns with the kids. Or try making your own dress-up creations. Either way, this adventure is sure to lead to lots of imaginative play!



YOU WILL NEED

- Foraged sticks and leaves
- A paint pen – a white Posca works well
- Cardboard
- Tape – we used Super Hold Tape, Double Sided Tape and Packaging Tape by Scotch
- Scissors and/or a utility knife
- A hot glue gun

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Decorate your sticks and leaves with a paint pen.
- 2 Cut a length of cardboard and roll it up. Then measure it around your child's head and tape it up.
- 3 Tape your sticks individually to the crown.

- 4 Wrap some packaging tape around to keep it secure.

- 5 Stick the leaves on with a hot glue gun. You can also try double sided tape on any hard-to-stick leaves (drier leaves stick best).
