

Mixed Media: GALAXY PROJECT



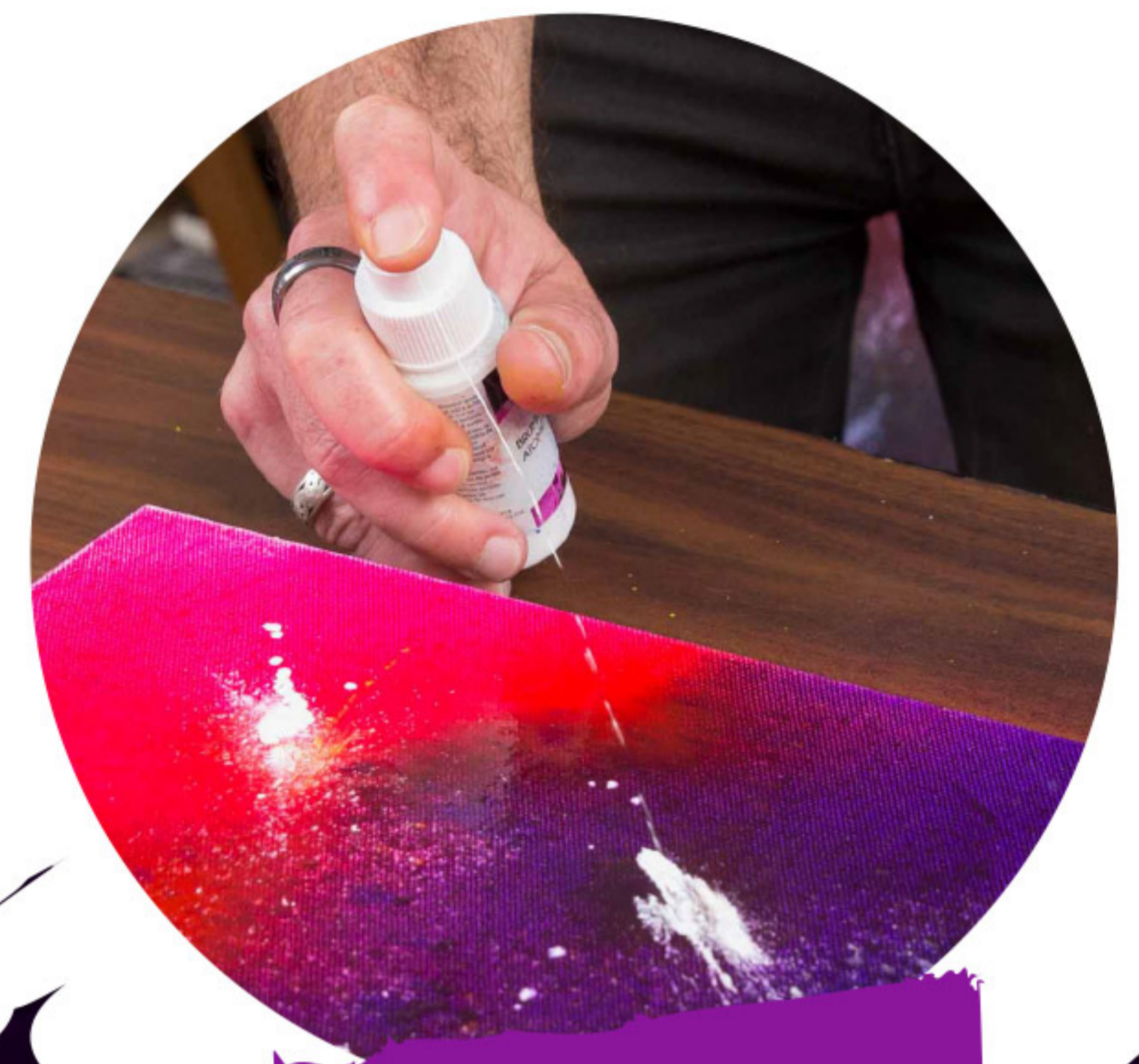
step 1

Add multiple layers of different colours on a primed surface of your choice.



step 2

Once surface is covered completely add yellow (e.g) at random, sparingly.



step 3

Repeat step 2 with a different colour, e.g white.

tips

1. Choose mister colours that will work together for the galaxy effect. We recommend – Purple, Red, Primary Cyan, Primary Magenta, Primary Yellow and you will definitely need White.
2. Avoid covering the same area with different colours when layering your initial colours in various areas on your surface.
3. Your base of different colours should be nice and wet before you apply the spattered yellow and white to allow for a nice soft bleed of the white and achieve the galaxy effect.
4. To spatter your colours push down gently just halfway on your mister. Practice this on a spare piece of paper.
5. A firm push on your Mister will result in a fine even spray.
6. Don't forget to cover your work surface with newspaper to catch any over-spray and to wear an apron or old clothes.
7. Varnish coats are optional but give an added depth to your artwork to really make it stand out.



step 4

Allow to dry.



step 5

Once completely dry (not sticky to touch), apply 2-3 coats of media Gloss Varnish to finish your artwork.
