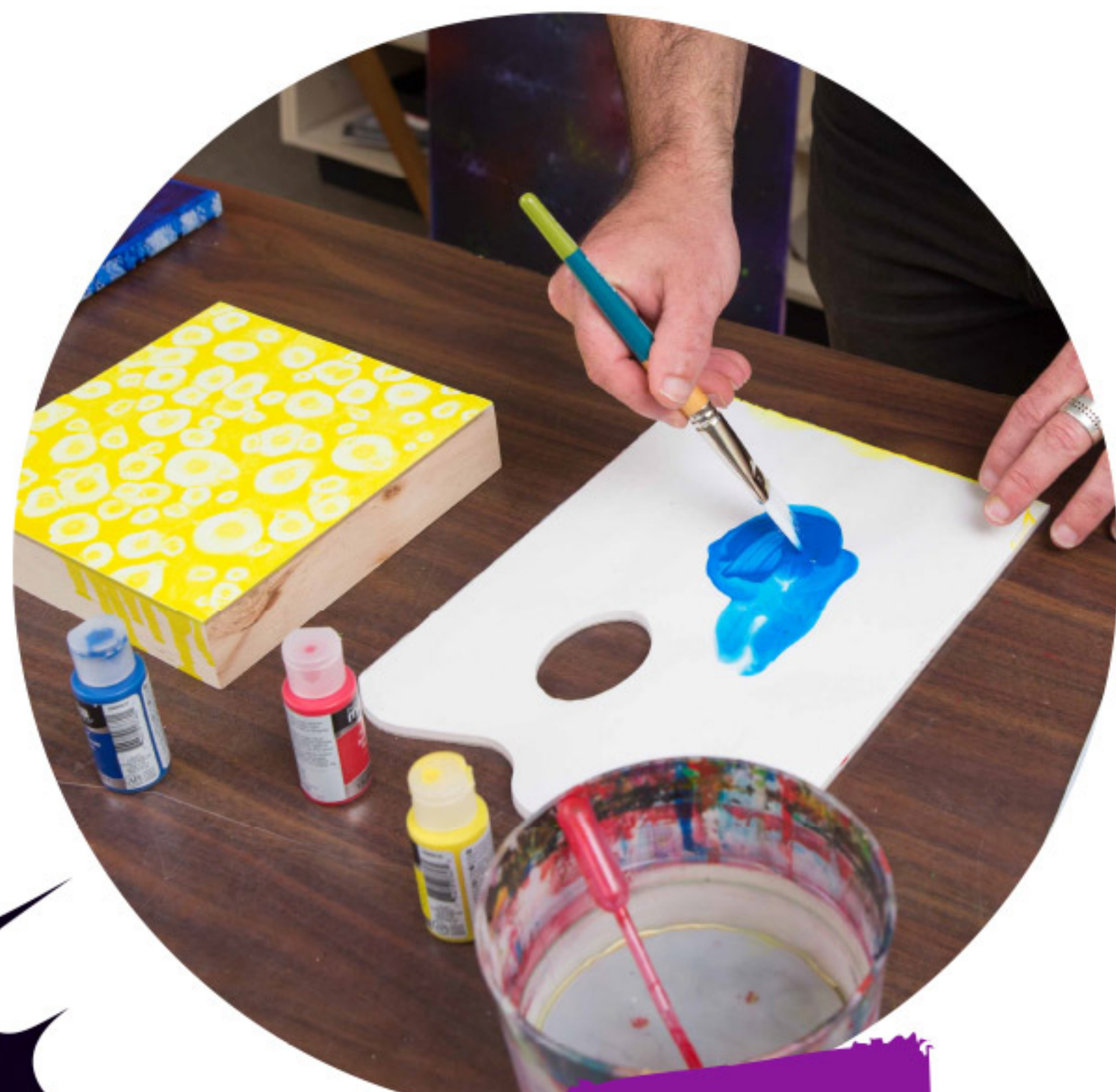


Mixed Media: RAINDROPS PROJECT



step 1

Mix 50% water with
50% Hansa Yellow Light
Media Fluid Acrylic.



step 2

Paint generously
over your surface.



step 3

Using the handle of your
brush or a pipette drip
Helmar ISO PRO into the
wet thinned paint until you
have the effect you want.

tips

1. Use generous amounts of your paint and water mix.
2. ISO PRO must be dropped into the paint while still wet or the effect won't work.
3. If there is too much paint on your artwork after you have dropped in the ISO PRO a soft cloth may be carefully laid on the surface and lifted to remove excess.
4. Each layer must be dry before starting the next.
5. Try using Titanium White Media Fluid Acrylic to add an interesting final coat
6. Try layering colours in a different sequence for different interesting effects.
7. Display different colour combination artworks next to each other for contrast.
8. For an added lift to your artwork consider applying 2-3 coats DecoArt Media Gloss Varnish.

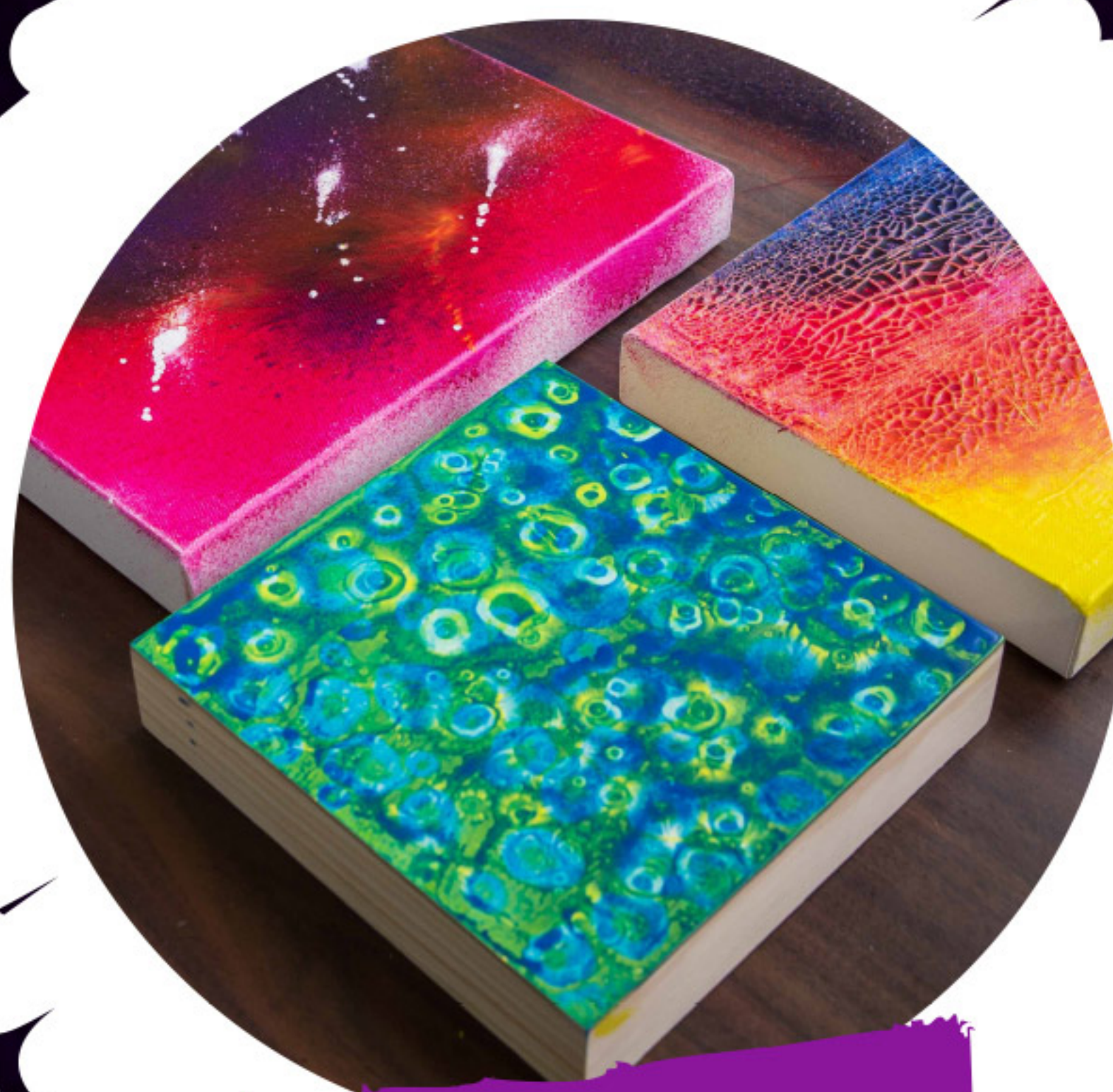


step 4

Allow to dry.

Repeat step 1 through
4 using Titanium White
Media Fluid Acrylic.

step 5

Repeat Step 1 through
4 using Primary Cyan
Media Fluid Acrylic.
Then repeat step 1
through 4 using
Pyrrole Red Media
Fluid Acrylic.



What you will need?

- > DecoArt Media Fluid Acrylics in Primary Cyan, Pyrrole Red, Hansa Yellow Lt (Titanium White is optional)
- > Helmar ISO PRO Cleaner
- > Wide flat paint brush
- > Water
- > Palette
- > A piece of gesso primed MDF or a DAS Exhibition Gesso Board
