Reeves Tear Off Palettes are a convenient surface for colour mixing. Contains 40 sheets.




Reeves Palette Knives are ideal for both mixing and applying colour. Assorted shapes for different effects.



## TRY THESE *Techniques* FOR YOUR HOME

### SPLATTER EFFECT

- Paint your entire canvas with Reeves Titanium White.
- In a plastic cup, mix 3 parts Reeves Mars Black paint with 1 part water.
- Using a large brush, dip the brush into the black paint mixture and splatter on to your canvas. Repeat with a metallic colour and a small brush to add some colour and size variation. Experiment with the fluidity of the paint for different splatter effects.
- You could also use scrunched cling film or foil to stamp paint onto your canvas for another interesting patterned effect.

### COLOURED, SMOOTH PLASTER EFFECT

- On your mixing palette, mix Reeves Modelling Paste and your Reeves pastel colour of choice.
- Using a palette knife, spread the colour across the top half of your canvas. Make it as smooth as possible.
- When completely dry sand with a medium grade sandpaper to a smooth velvety finish.

### TEXTURED CONCRETE EFFECT

- Squeeze out a blob of Modelling Paste onto your palette. Add Mars Black and mix.
- Using a palette knife roughly spread the black paint across the bottom of the canvas. Wait for this to dry. Repeat with Reeves Titanium White allow to dry and then with Medium Grey.
- Use a scraping action with your palette knife so areas of the underneath colour show though creating interesting and random textures. Repeat as many times as required to achieve the desired effect.

### COLOURED BANDS AND GEOMETRIC DESIGNS

- Use masking tape to create perfect lines.
- Use 2 coats of paint to achieve a solid flat colour.

### OTHER DECOR IDEAS

- Acrylic paints are versatile and can be used on many surfaces including wood, cardboard, terracotta, plastic and fabric. For best results use Reeves Gesso to prepare the surface.
- Paint a band of copper around the base of a concrete or white plant pot, glass bottle, an old vase or candle holder to restyle.
- Paint up some old brick-a-brack with metallic paint and hang on the wall ie Old gardening equipment, kitchen utensils, wooden wheels, plates, pots, baskets, old picture frames etc.
- On a plain background stencil on a simple motif in black or metallics.
