



## DIY DOLLHOUSE WALLPAPER

Clever poppy.

Turn your child's dollhouse from drab to fab by simply adding wallpaper. It's such a fun way to add some character to this little house shelf. Get ready to open up a world of creativity and play!



### YOU WILL NEED

- Uniti DIY Wood House Shelf
- Decorative paper
- Mod Podge
- A medium-sized paintbrush
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Scissors

### INSTRUCTIONS

**1** Working one room at a time, measure the back area of the room and the two sides. You can either

measure it out or hold the paper over each space to trace/estimate the size. Paper that is cut slightly smaller than the area works best, but don't worry if it's not perfect.

**2** Cut each area out. Then check the paper will fit each side of the room, and trim if needed.

**3** Starting with one wall, apply a generous dollop of Mod Podge and brush it right over the area.

**4** Now carefully place the decorative paper over top of the glued

section, gently smoothing out any air bubbles as you go.

**5** Once the wallpaper is in place, brush over a generous top-coat of Mod Podge. Don't worry it dries clear.

**6** Repeat this for the other rooms - you can do the back and side walls, as well as the ceiling and floors if you wish. You can also brush a layer of Mod Podge over any bare wood walls left inside (especially if they're been dripped on) to give a nice overall finish.
