Christmas is coming, and what better way to celebrate your wonderful family, than by turning them into a flock of Christmas Angel decorations?!



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Cut out the tunic and a pair of wings, arms, and legs from the designer papers. You can do this freehand, or use our templates as a guide (you can scale the template to suit your photo sizes).
- 2 Cut out the head of your angel from the photo. Stick this to the front side of the tunic, by using clear sticky tape on the underside. Also, stick the wings to the underside of the tunic.
- 3 Arrange the legs so that they are coming out from underneath the bottom of the tunic. Use the point of your scissors (in a swivel motion) to make a little hole
- 4 Arrange the arms on top of the tunic, and attach as per step 3.
- 5 Create the halo shape by twisting the end of a chenille stick into a round shape and trimming the excess stick. Then tape the halo's stick to the underside of the angel's head.
- 6 Use clear sticky tape to attach a loop of twine to the underside of the angel, ready for hanging on your Christmas tree.

YOU WILL NEED

- Printed family photos
- Designer papers (we chose a festive vibe!)
- Glitter Chenille Sticks
- Paper Binders
- Clear sticky tape (we used Scotch Super-Hold Tape)
- Twine or string
- Scissors and a pencil
