




## DIY EASTER PEG PUPPETS

Clever poppy.



Have fun with your little ones this Easter, by making mini Easter Egg Puppets, with pegs!



### YOU WILL NEED

- American Craft Cardstock (we used Mustard 12x12)
- Printed photos (you need small sized heads about 20mm long)
- Wooden pegs (we used Bamboo pegs from The Warehouse)
- Elmers PVA School Glue
- Felt Tip Pens
- Small scissors
- Pencil

### INSTRUCTIONS

- 1** Draw an Easter egg shape on the card, with a jagged line at the midway point. Decorate with cute designs, then cut it out.
- 2** Use your paintbrush to dab glue to the lower side of the peg.
- 3** Stick the bottom half of the egg to the peg, lining up the jagged edge with the opening. Leave to dry.
- 4** Repeat step 4 with the top half. Be careful not to glue the egg together when the peg closes!
- 5** Cut out the head from your photo, and double check it's the right size when the peg is fully open.
- 6** Now add glue to the top of the head. Then stick it to the top side of the peg, on the underside.
