

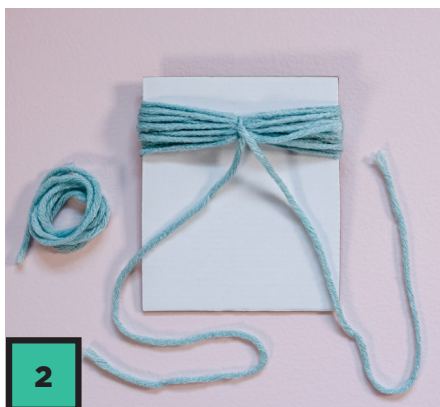


DIY TASSEL WALL HANGING

Clever

Let's make a fun and gorgeous wall hanging for your home! The key to this project is learning how to make a yarn tassel. Once you've got the hang of it, you can try all sorts of decor projects with tassels, starting with this eye-catching wall hanging.



YOU WILL NEED

- Yarn - I used 4 different colours
- Sharp scissors
- A sturdy piece of cardboard
- A piece of dowel or rod
- Ruler

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Cut your cardboard into a piece about 12 cm width. Then wrap your yarn around it approx 30 times and cut off the end.
- 2 Cut 2 pieces of yarn, each approx 80 cm long. Slide a piece under one side of the bundle of yarn, then tie it tightly in the middle.
- 3 Flip over the bundle and cut through all of the strands on the opposite side.
- 4 Remove the cardboard and smooth the tassel down.
- 5 Take the second piece of cut yarn and wrap it around the tassel about 10 times then knot securely. Hide the knot under the wrapped yarn.
- 6 Repeat to make 9 tassels, then tie each one to the dowel. Tie a piece of wool to the top as the hanger.
