



DIY WOODEN PHOTO TRANSFERS

Clever poppy.

Need a crafty way to display photos? Try using craft glue to transfer them onto wood.

YOU WILL NEED

- Mod Podge – I used the plain matte version
- Images which you've printed using a laser printer
- Wooden rounds
- A brush
- Scissors
- A cloth
- A bowl of water

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1** Print your photos on normal paper using a laser printer
Tip: Your photo will be revealed in reverse on the wood, so you might want to reflect it digitally before you print.
- 2** Cut the photos out into circles.
- 3** Paint Mod Podge craft glue over the image on the printed side, then press it into place on your wooden rounds. Give 24 hours to dry
Tip: make sure your wooden rounds have a smooth surface.
- 4** Wet your photo with a cloth, then rub the top layer off the paper with your finger
Tip: Dab more water to help lift the top layer, but don't rub too hard
- 5** When the paper is dry, paint Mod Podge over the photo. Once it's dry, you're done.
