Print speed may vary depending on system configuration, interface, software, document complexity, print mode, page coverage, type of paper used etc. 2. Copy speeds are the average of sFCOT and sESAT, ISO/IEC 29183. Copy speed may vary depending on document complexity, copy mode, page coverage, type of paper used etc. and does not take into account warming up time. 3. Optical resolution is a measure of maximum hardware sampling resolution, based on ISO 14473 standard. 4. Colour document scan speed is measured with ISO/IEC 29183 Target A. Scan speed indicates the time measured between pressing the scan button of the scanner driver and the on-screen status display turns off.
